#### Chapter 46.

An Act to amend Paragraph one, Section six, of Chapter six of the Revised Statutes, relating to Property exempt from Taxation.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section I. Paragraph one of section six of chapter six of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding to said paragraph the following words and the property of any public municipal corporation of this state, appropriated to public uses,' so said paragraph one of section six will read as follows:

Paragraph 1 of section 6 of chapter 6 of R. S., amended.

'Section 6. Paragraph I. The property of the United States, and of this state, and the property of any public municipal corporation of this state, appropriated to public uses.'

Paragraph 1, as amended.

Section 2. This act shall take effect when approved.

Approved March 4, 1903.

### Chapter 47.

An Act to repeal sections forty, forty-two and one hundred twenty-eight of Chapter fifty-one of the Revised Statutes, relating to Railroads.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section I. Sections forty, forty-two and one hundred twenty-eight of chapter fifty-one of the revised statutes, are hereby repealed.

Sections 40, 42, and 128 of chapter 51, R. S. repealed.

Section 2. This act shall take effect when approved.

#### Chapter 48.

An Act to amend Chapter ninety-seven of the Fublic Laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-seven, relating to assessment of damages resulting from the raising and lowering of Ways.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section I. Section one of chapter ninety-seven of the public laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-seven, is hereby amended, by adding at the end of said section the following words: 'said complaint to be filed at the term of the supreme judicial court, next to be held within the county where the land is situated,
