Chapter 57.

An Act to amend Chapter one hundred and fifty-two of the Public Laws of eighteen hundred ninety-five, relating to State Examination and certification of Teachers.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Chapter one hundred and fifty-two of the public laws of eighteen hundred ninety-five is hereby amended by inserting after the word "examination" in the third line of section four of said chapter the words, 'and certification,' so that said section, as amended, shall read as follows:

'Section 4. The certificates issued under the provisions of this act shall be accepted by school committees, supervisors and superintendents in lieu of the personal examination and certification required by section eighty-seven, chapter eleven, of the revised statutes and all amendments thereto.'

Section 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this act, are hereby repealed.

Chapter 58.

An Act to amend Chapter two hundred and seventy-three of the Public Laws of eighteen hundred eighty-five, relating to the holding of County Teachers' Conventions.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Chapter two hundred and seventy-three of the public laws of eighteen hundred eighty-five is hereby amended by inserting after the word "counties" in the fourth line of section two of said chapter the following words, namely: 'and also for not more than two days in any year during the sessions of any state teachers' convention approved by the state superintendent of public schools,' so that said section, as amended by this act, shall read as follows:
