Chapter 234.

An Act establishing the Salary of the County Attorney for the County of Knox.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The county attorney for the county of Knox shall receive an annual salary from the treasurer of state, of seven hundred dollars, payable quarterly on the first days of January, April, July and October in each year, beginning on the first day of April, one thousand nine hundred and three, instead of the salary now provided by law.

Section 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this act, are hereby repealed.
