#### Chapter 240.

An Act fixing a time when other Acts and Resolves shall take effect.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Except as provided in the following section, all acts passed by the seventy-first legislature, and approved prior to the approval of this act, shall take effect on the April 28, 1903. Section 1. Except as provided in the following section, all twenty-eighth day of April, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and three.

This act shall not apply to acts of incorporation, nor to acts and resolves which by their own terms take effect at times other than the day last named.

Exceptions.

Section 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
