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**Chapter 48.**

An Act to amend Chapter sixty-four of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-nine as amended by Chapter four hundred and seventy-two of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred and one, relating to the Wilson Stream Dam Company.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The organization of the Wilson Stream Dam Company, a corporation chartered by a special act of the legislature, chapter sixty-four of the private and special laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-nine, as amended by chapter four hundred and seventy-two of the private and special laws of nineteen hundred and one, the certificate of which organization was filed in the office of the secretary of state, December seventeen, nineteen hundred and two, is hereby ratified and confirmed, and all acts of said corporation done in pursuance of said charter and amendment, are hereby made valid and legal.

Organization of Wilson Stream Dam Company ratified and confirmed.

Section 2. And said charter is hereby further amended by striking out all of section four of said chapter sixty-four of the private and special laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-nine, and inserting the following: 'Said corporation in addition to the powers already conferred upon it, is hereby further authorized and empowered at all times to store and hold, by means of the dams mentioned in said original charter and said amendment, water for all domestic, sanitary, manufacturing, industrial, municipal and commercial purposes, and said corporation can use said water for any and all said purposes, and to create power for any and all such purposes, and said corporation can in any manner sell, lease, or otherwise dispose of, the use of said water for any and all such purposes, or to create power for any and all such purposes, to any person, party or corporation, municipal or otherwise. Provided, however, the water stored in said dams shall be used at all times so far as necessary for log driving purposes on said Wilson stream.'

Charter further amended.
