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opinion that its investments are not in accordance with law, or said corporation is insolvent, or its condition is such as to render its further proceedings hazardous to the public or to those having funds in its custody, or is of the opinion that it has exceeded its powers or failed to comply with any of the rules or restrictions provided by law, he shall have such authority and take such action as is provided for in the case of savings banks by chapter forty-seven of the revised statutes and amendments or additions thereto. He shall preserve in a permanent form a full record of his proceedings, including a statement of the condition of said corporation. A copy of such statement shall be published by said corporation immediately after the annual examination of the same in some newspaper published where such corporation is established. If no paper is published in the town where said corporation is established, then it shall be published in a newspaper printed in the nearest city or town. The necessary expenses of the bank examiner while making such examination shall be paid by the corporation.

—shall keep a record and publish a statement annually.

Section 16. Any three of the corporators named in this act may call the first meeting of the corporation by mailing a written notice, signed by all, postage paid, to each of the other corporators, seven days at least before the day of the meeting, naming the time, place and purpose of such meeting, and at such meeting the necessary officers may be chosen, by-laws adopted, and any other corporate business transacted.

First meeting, how called.

Section 17. This act shall take effect when approved.

### Chapter 59.

An Act to amend an act entitled "An Act to ratify the mortgage of the Fish River Railroad," approved February eleven, nineteen hundred and three.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Section one of an act entitled "An Act to ratify the mortgage of the Fish River Railroad," approved February eleven, nineteen hundred and three, is hereby amended by substituting for the word "Central" therein the word 'City' so that said section as amended, shall read as follows:

Section 1, laws of 1903, amended.

'Section 1. The mortgage of the Fish River Railroad made by the Fish River Railroad Company to the City Trust Company dated January one in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and two, is hereby made valid, ratified and confirmed.'

Mortgage made valid.

Section 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
