CHAP. 103**Chapter 103.**

An Act to legalize the acts and doings of the town of Williamsburg.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

All acts and doings of the town of Williamsburg, Maine, prior to this date are hereby legalized and made valid.

Approved March 4, 1903.

Chapter 104.

An Act extending the charter and changing the name of the Van Buren Trust and Banking Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Charter
extended.

Section 1. Chapter two hundred and seventy-six of the private and special laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-five entitled "An Act to Incorporate the Van Buren Trust and Banking Company," as amended by chapter one hundred and thirty-one of the private and special laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-nine, as extended by chapter three hundred and thirty-seven of the private and special laws of nineteen hundred and one is hereby continued in force and the persons named in said act, as amended, are hereby given a period of two years from the date of the approval of this act in which to organize and commence business.

Section 2. The name of the Van Buren Trust and Banking Company is hereby changed to Van Buren Trust Company.

Section 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
