Chapter 205.

An Act additional to the acts which constitute the charter of the trustees of Hebron Academy.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. All acts and doings of the trustees of Hebron Academy in the town of Hebron, county of Oxford, in constructing and acquiring a line of poles and wires thereon from Mechanic Falls village in the town of Mechanic Falls, county of Androscoggin, to Hebron Academy in the town of Hebron aforesaid, for the purpose of obtaining electricity for lighting purposes in the buildings and property of Hebron Academy, is hereby approved and declared to be legal and valid, and the contract now in force between the trustees of Hebron Academy and the Mechanic Falls Water and Electric Light and Power Company is hereby approved, and the trustees of Hebron Academy are hereby granted the right to maintain said line of poles and wires, for said purposes, between said points, subject to existing provisions of law, and to make and execute additional contract or contracts with said Mechanic Falls Water and Electric Light and Power Company, or any other person or corporation to furnish electricity to be used within said town of Hebron.

Doings of trustees in acquiring line of poles and wires declared valid.

—contract between trustees and Mechanic Falls Water and Electric Light and Power Co., approved.

Section 2. The trustees of Hebron Academy are hereby authorized and empowered to construct and maintain a line of poles and wires thereon, at any point within the town of Hebron, subject to all existing provisions of law or laws hereinafter enacted, regulating the use of electricity, and when said pole line is established, shall have the right to make contracts with persons and corporations for the lighting of streets or buildings within said town of Hebron, and collect and receive such compensation therefor as may be mutually agreed between the parties and may sell or lease their pole lines, franchises and fixtures belonging to the same, at any time when they deem it for their interest.

Trustees may maintain line in town of Hebron.
