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#### MACHIAS LOG DRIVING COMPANY,

 $\frac{C\text{HAP. 288}}{\text{Capital stock.}}$ 

Section 4. The amount of capital stock shall be fixed by vote of the corporation, but not to exceed ten thousand dollars and said corporation may purchase, hold, sell and convey real estate and personal property necessary for the purposes contemplated in this charter.

First meeting, how called. Section 5. Any of the corporators named in this act may call the first meeting of this company by mailing a written notice to each of the other corporators, seven days at least, before the day of meeting, naming the time, place, and purposes of such meeting; and at such meeting, a president, secretary, treasurer and directors may be chosen, by-laws adopted and any corporate business transacted.

Section 6. This act shall take effect when approved.

#### Chapter 288.

An Act to amend An Act entitled "An Act to incorporate the Machias Log Driving Company," approved April eighth, one thousand eight hundred and fifty-four.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section eleven of an act entitled "An Act to incorporate the Machias Log Driving Company," approved April eighth, one thousand eight hundred and fifty-four, is hereby repealed.

Section 2. Said act is hereby amended by adding thereto the following :

'All persons or corporations or their agents owning logs or other timber to be driven on said waters at the date of the annual meeting in each year shall be members of the Machias Log Driving Company and shall continue so for two years at least from that date and shall have all the privileges and be subject to all the liabilities thereof.'

Section 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
