Chapter 384.

An Act relative to Treasurer and Collector of Taxes of the City of Waterville.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The treasurer and collector of taxes of the city of Waterville, may be one and the same person.

Section 2. This act shall take effect when approved.

Treasurer and collector may be same person.

Chapter 385.

An Act relative to the Treasurer and Collector of the City of Bangor.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section I. The treasurer and collector of taxes in and for the city of Bangor, may be one and the same person.

Section 2. This act shall take effect when approved.

Chapter 386.

An Act relative to the Treasurer and Collector of Taxes for the Town of Brownfield.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The treasurer and collector of taxes in and for the Treasurer town of Brownfield, may be one and the same person.

Section 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
