CHAP. 415**Chapter 415.**

An Act to annex certain Islands in Casco Bay to the County of Sagadahoc and the town of Phippsburg.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Islands
annexed to
Phippsburg.

Section 1. Bushy, Hen, Bear, Malaga, Burnt Coat, Black-snake, Wood, Little Wood, Gooseberry, Flag, Mark, East Brown and Cow islands are hereby made and declared to be part of the county of Sagadahoc and of the town of Phippsburg therein.

Section 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
