Chapter 6.

Resolve in favor of Benjamin Smith of Appleton in Knox County.

Resolved, That Benjamin Smith of Appleton in the county of Knox, be paid the sum of ten dollars per month, commencing January one, nineteen hundred three, instead of the sum of eight dollars per month which he now receives.

Chapter 7.

Resolve providing for the compensation of Steamboat Inspectors for the years nineteen hundred, nineteen hundred and one, and nineteen hundred and two.

Resolved, That the sum of one thousand eighty-seven dollars and thirty-two cents be and is hereby appropriated to pay John M. Taylor the compensation for the years nineteen hundred, nineteen hundred and one, and nineteen hundred and two, to which as steamboat inspector he is entitled, under chapter fifty-two, section twenty-three of the revised statutes; and that the further sum of eight hundred ninety-two dollars and sixteen cents be and is hereby appropriated to pay Horace Atwood the compensation for the years nineteen hundred, nineteen hundred and one, and nineteen hundred and two, to which as steamboat inspector he is entitled, under chapter fifty-two, section twenty-three of the revised statutes.
