Chapter 19.

Resolve in favor of the purchase of the Maine State Year Book and Legislative Manual for the years nineteen hundred and three and nineteen hundred and four.

Resolved, That the secretary of state be authorized to contract for six hundred and fifty copies of the Maine State Year Book and Legislative Manual for nineteen hundred and three; also nine hundred and fifty copies of same for nineteen hundred and four, to be delivered on or before the first day of June of each year, at a cost not to exceed two dollars per copy. One hundred and fifty of said copies for each year to be delivered to the state librarian for the use of the state library, the remainder to be distributed in the usual manner.

Chapter 20.

Resolve in favor of the town of Sanford.

Resolved, That there be paid out of the school fund for the year one thousand nine hundred and two, to the town of Sanford, the sum of eight hundred fifty-nine dollars and twenty-three cents, being the amount due said town, on account of its failure to make its annual return, by reason of sickness of its superintendent.

Chapter 21.

Resolve providing for paying to the city of Rockland the amount deducted from its school fund for the year one thousand nine hundred and two, on account of imperfect school returns.

Resolved, That there be paid out of the school fund for the year one thousand nine hundred and three to the city of Rockland, the sum of four hundred sixty-two dollars and eighty-seven cents, being the amount deducted from said city's proportion of the school fund for the year one thousand nine hundred and two, on account of defect in its school returns.
