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**Chapter 38.**

Resolve in favor of the committee on Revision of the Statutes.

*Resolved,* That the sum of four hundred and forty-six dollars and fifty cents be and is hereby appropriated for desks, typewriters and other necessary office supplies for the use of the committee on revision of the statutes; same to be expended by direction of the governor and council.

**Chapter 39.**

Resolve in favor of the Town of Trescott.

*Resolved,* That the sum of three hundred dollars be and is hereby appropriated, to wit; one hundred and fifty dollars for the year nineteen hundred and three, and one hundred and fifty dollars for the year nineteen hundred and four, to the town of Trescott in maintaining its roads and bridges, said sums to be expended under the direction of the county commissioners of Washington county.

**Chapter 40.**

Resolve in favor of the Maine School for the Deaf.

*Resolved,* That there be and hereby is appropriated for the Maine School for the Deaf, the sum of seventeen thousand five hundred dollars for the year nineteen hundred and three; also the sum of seventeen thousand five hundred dollars for the year nineteen hundred and four. Also the sum of six thousand dollars for the purchase of a building and lot to be used as a home for the pupils.

**Chapter 41.**

Resolve in favor of repairing elevator in State House.

*Resolved,* That the sum of six hundred dollars be hereby appropriated for the purpose of repairing the elevator in the State House at Augusta, said appropriation to be expended under the direction of the superintendent of public buildings.
