Resolve in favor of the Committee on Maine State Prison.

Resolved, That the sum of fifty-four dollars and twenty-five cents be paid to Albert R. Buck, chairman of the committee on Maine state prison, for expenses incurred by him in complying with an order of the legislature dated February six, nineteen hundred and three.

Resolve in favor of C. C. Libby, chairman of the Committee on Education.

Resolved, That the state treasurer be directed to pay to C. C. Libby, chairman of the committee on education, the sum of one hundred and fifty-seven dollars and fifty cents, the same being the expenses of the said committee on its recent visits to the various normal, training and industrial schools, and to Presque Isle to view the site of the proposed new normal school.

Chapter 61.

Resolve in favor of the town of Island Falls.

Resolved, That the state treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to pay to the town of Island Falls the sum of one hundred and fifteen dollars and fifty cents, it being an abatement, in part, for taxes assessed by the state against the town of Island Falls for the years eighteen hundred and ninety-nine and nineteen hundred.
