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CHAP. 92**Chapter 92.**

Resolve in favor of Castine State Normal School.

*Resolved,* That there be and is hereby appropriated the sum of two thousand dollars for the year nineteen hundred and three, and two thousand dollars for the year nineteen hundred and four, for the purchase of land adjoining the normal school lot in Castine, and for putting in water into the school buildings, and for necessary repairs.

**Chapter 93.**

Resolve in favor of the Town of Anson.

*Resolved,* That the sum of five thousand dollars be and is hereby appropriated to the inhabitants of the town of Anson, to aid them in the purchase of the Norridgewock falls bridge, which extends across the Kennebec river between the villages of Anson and Madison. Said sum is to be paid to the treasurer of the said town of Anson when the county commissioners of Somerset county shall certify that the inhabitants of said Anson and Madison have purchased said bridge of the proprietors thereof and have made it a bridge free for public travel.
