**Chapter 139.**

Resolve in favor of building a Bridge across the Mattawamkeag River in the Town of Bancroft.

*Resolved,* That the sum of twelve hundred dollars be and hereby is appropriated for the year nineteen hundred four, for the purpose of assisting in the construction of a steel bridge across the Mattawamkeag river in the town of Bancroft, and that the same be paid when the county commissioners of Aroostook county shall certify to the governor and council, that said bridge has been completed at a cost of not less than three thousand six hundred dollars. And the county of Aroostook is hereby authorized to appropriate the sum of twelve hundred dollars to aid in the construction of said bridge.

**Chapter 140.**

Resolve in favor of repairing the Bridge across the St. Croix River near Squirrel Point in Baileyville.

*Resolved,* That the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars be and hereby is appropriated for the year nineteen hundred and three, in aid of repairing the bridge across the St. Croix river at or near Squirrel Point in Baileyville and known as the Squirrel Point bridge, the same to be expended by an agent to be appointed by the county commissioners of Washington county, said amount to be paid upon the certificate of said commissioners, that said bridge has been thoroughly repaired at an expense of not less than five hundred dollars.

**Chapter 141.**

Resolve in favor of the Town of Parkman.

*Resolved,* That the sum of one hundred seventy-three dollars and eleven cents be and hereby is appropriated from the state treasury to reimburse the town of Parkman, for money expended in the commitment and support of Luella Harvey in the insane asylum at Augusta, Maine.
