Resolve to provide for the expense of examination of candidates for the Cecil John Rhodes scholarships.

Resolved, That the sum of one hundred dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated, annually, to pay the expense of the examination of candidates for the Cecil John Rhodes scholarships, the same, or such part thereof as may be necessary, to be expended under the direction of the state superintendent of public schools.

Chapter 145.

Resolve in favor of Maine State Prison.

Maine State

Resolved, That the sum of thirty-seven thousand one hundred and thirty-six dollars and sixteen cents be and hereby is appropriated for and in behalf of the Maine state prison to be expended under the direction and supervision of the governor and council. Six thousand six hundred and thirty-six dollars and sixteen cents deficiency in insane department; eight thousand dollars for sewer; two thousand dollars for repairs of buildings; two thousand five hundred dollars to pay for bills and notes outstanding and due; seven thousand five hundred dollars for current expenses; seven thousand five hundred dollars for current expenses for the year nineteen hundred and four.
