Appropricommission.

Section 5. It is further provided that there shall be and hereby is appropriated for the work of said commission, including all expenses, the sum of ten thousand dollars for the year nineteen hundred and five and a like sum for the year nineteen hundred and six.

Section 6. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

Chapter 145.

An Act authorizing the compilation of the Sea and Shore Fishery Laws.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

The governor is hereby authorized to appoint a competent compilation person to compile the sea and shore fishery laws of the state, including all such laws passed at the present session, and cause authorized. three thousand copies of said compilation to be printed and bound, in convenient form, for the use of the department of sea and shore fisheries, to be distributed among the fishermen of the state. The compensation for the work authorized and --compensa performed under this act shall be determined and allowed by the governor and council, and paid from any funds in the treasury not otherwise appropriated.

Chapter 146.

An Act to provide for the appointment of a Commissioner of Highways and Economy in Municipal Expenditures.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The governor, with the advice and consent of commisthe council, within thirty days after approval of this act, shall appoint a suitable person, who shall be a civil engineer, as commissioner of highways; who shall hold his office for the term __tenure of four years and until his successor is appointed and qualified, and shall receive an annual salary of two thousand five hundred -salary. dollars, and in addition thereto one thousand dollars for assistant, or clerk hire, the actual amount paid out for his traveling -elerk hire. expenses within this state, and such other expenses, not exceed- -expenses.
