#### Chapter 215.

An Act to repeal Chapter two hundred sixty-four of the Laws of eighteen hundred twenty-four, as amended by Chapter four hundred fifty-nine of the Laws of eighteen hundred twenty-seven, and Chapter two hundred fifty-eight of the Laws of eighteen hundred eighty-seven, relating to the fisheries in the waters of Vinalhaven.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section I. Chapter two hundred sixty-four of the laws of eighteen hundred twenty-four, as amended by chapter four hundred fifty-nine of the laws of eighteen hundred twenty-seven and chapter two hundred fifty-eight of the laws of eighteen hundred eighty-seven, entitled "An Act respecting fisheries in the waters of Vinalhaven," is hereby repealed.

Section 2. This act shall take effect when approved.

#### Chapter 216.

An Act to extend the charter of the Buckfield Water, Power and Electric Light Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Charter extended. Section 1. All the rights, powers and privileges of the Buckfield Water, Power and Electric Light Company which were granted by chapter two hundred sixty-seven of the private and special laws of nineteen hundred and three are hereby extended for a term of two years.

Section 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
