Chapter 13.

An Act to amend the charter of the Security Trust Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. That section two of the charter of the Security Trust Company, amended by chapter twenty-eight of the private and special laws of the state of Maine for the year nineteen hundred and five, be and is hereby further amended by striking out in said section the words "at Vinalhaven" and inserting in place thereof the words 'in each of the towns of Vinalhaven and Warren' so that said section as amended, shall read as follows:

Charter amended.

'Section 2. The corporation hereby chartered shall be located at Rockland, Knox county, Maine, and may establish in each of the towns of Vinalhaven and Warren in said Knox county, a branch, the business of which shall in the same manner as the business at the main office of the corporation, be under the direction and control of the directors and executive board of said corporation.'

Location.

—may establish branches.

Section 2. This act shall take effect when approved.

Chapter 14.

An Act to extend the time of construction of the Boothbay Railroad.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The time within which the Boothbay Railroad Company may commence construction of its line is hereby extended to March first, in the year nineteen hundred and nine.

Time of construction extended.

Section 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
