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**Chapter 33.**

An Act to extend the charter of the Stonington Trust Company.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. All the rights, powers and privileges of the Stonington Trust Company which were granted by chapter two hundred and sixty-six of the private and special laws of one thousand nine hundred and five, are hereby extended for and during the period of two years from the eighteenth day of March, in the year of our Lord, one thousand nine hundred and seven. And all the rights, powers and privileges that were granted by said act, may and shall be exercised in the same manner and for the same purposes as provided in said act.

Section 2. This act shall take effect when approved.

**Chapter 34.**

An Act to extend the charter of the Bethel Trust Company.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The rights, powers and privileges of the Bethel Trust Company, located at Bethel, Oxford county, Maine, which were granted by chapter sixty of the private and special laws of nineteen hundred five, approved February seventeenth, in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and five, are hereby extended for two years from the approval of this act; and the persons named in said act, their associates and successors shall have all the rights, powers and privileges that were granted them by said act, to be exercised in the same manner and for the same purposes as specified therein.

Section 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
