Chapter 69.

An Act to authorize the City of Bath to raise money by the issue of bonds for the construction of sewers.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The city of Bath is hereby authorized to issue bonds to an amount not exceeding fifty thousand dollars for the purpose of constructing main sewers in said city in accordance with the provisions of chapter twenty-one of the revised statutes nineteen hundred three and acts amendatory thereof and additional thereto and chapter twenty-two of the private and special laws of nineteen hundred three. Said bonds to be issued subject to the following restrictions.

Authorized to issue bonds not exceeding \$50,000.

A. Said bonds shall be four per cent coupon bonds, dated January first, nineteen hundred seven and due January first, nineteen hundred twenty-seven; they shall be in denominations of five hundred dollars each and shall be numbered from one to one hundred inclusive.

B. Said city shall not in any year sell or offer for sale more of said bonds than the amount appropriated that year by the city council for the reduction of the city debt.

Section 2. Said bonds shall be issued under the seal of the city and shall be signed by the mayor and treasurer of the city and the coupons attached to said bonds shall have printed or lithographed thereon the signature of the city treasurer.

Section 3. This act shall take effect when approved.

Chapter 70.

An Act to amend Chapter two hundred and twenty-two of the Private and Special Laws of the year nineteen hundred and three, entitled "An Act to authorize extensions of the Bangor and Aroostook Railroad in Aroostook, Piscataquis and Penobscot counties."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section one of chapter two hundred and twenty-two of the private and special laws of the year nineteen hundred and three is hereby amended by inserting between the words "extension" and "by" in the last line but one of said section, the following words: 'and a branch extending from a point of connection with the main line of said railroad either in Township Number four, Range nine, North of the Waldo Patent in Piscataquis county, or Township Long A, in Penobscot county, in a general southerly direction between Schoodic Lake and
