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### SCHOOL COMMITTEE IN LEWISTON-ORONO AND BRADLEY.

## Chapter 129.

An Act to amend section two of chapter four hundred sixty-five of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred sixty-eight, providing for the election of a superintending school committee and superintendent of schools in the city of Lewiston.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section two of chapter four hundred sixty-five of the private and special laws of eighteen hundred sixty-eight is hereby amended by inserting after the word "schools" in the fifth line thereof the words 'and truant officer;' also by striking out the words "city council" in the sixth line of said section and inserting in place thereof the words 'superintending school committee,' so that said section as amended, shall read as follows:

'Section 2. The superintending school committee of said city of Lewiston, may exercise all the powers conferred, and shall discharge all the duties imposed, by law, on superintending school committees and district school agents; and they may also appoint a superintendent of schools and truant officers, for such term and with such compensation as the superintending school committee of said city of Lewiston may determine. Such superintendent may be removed at the pleasure of said committee, and any vacancy shall be filled by their appointment.'

Section 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent herewith, are hereby repealed.

Section 3. This act shall take effect when approved.

#### Chapter 130.

An Act relating to the ferry across the Penobscot River, between the town of Orono and the town of Bradley.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section I. The right of Ulysses H. Walker of Orono, as owner of the franchise granted by chapter four hundred and fifty-three of the private and special laws of the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty-eight, and all acts additional thereto and amendatory thereof, to maintain and operate a ferry across the Penobscot river, to and fro between the town of Orono and the town of Bradley, shall be, and the same is hereby extended for the term of fifteen years, beginning with the third day of February in the year one thousand nine hundred and eight, and he is hereby authorized, during the term aforesaid, to continue
