#### ATLANTIC SHORE LINE RY .--- WHARF IN DEER ISLE.

#### Chapter 303.

An Act to authorize the Atlantic Shore Line Railway to discontinue operation of its ferry across the Piscataqua River in certain instances.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The Atlantic Shore Line Railway is hereby author-May dis-continue ized to discontinue the carriage of animals, vehicles and animals attached to vehicles upon its ferry across the Piscataqua river during such period or periods and at such time or times as it may elect not to engage in such carriage.

Section 2. Said corporation may close its bridge extending May close its bridge at from the main land to Kittery foreside to Badgers' island to times. travel by animals and vehicles and vehicles drawn by animals at such time or times and for such period or periods as it may elect.

This act shall take effect when approved. Section 3.

#### Chapter 304.

An Act authorizing the construction of a wharf into the tide waters of Jerico Bay in Deer Isle, Hancock County.

Be it enacted  $b_{\mathcal{N}}$  the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. William I. Conary, his associates and assigns, are hereby authorized to erect and maintain a wharf from the shore of his land on the southerly side of Stinson's neck in the town of Deer Isle, Hancock county, and to extend the same into the tide waters of Jerico bay, a distance not exceeding three hundred feet.

Section 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
