**Chapter 318.**

An Act to extend the charter of the Old Town Trust Company.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The rights, powers and privileges of the Old Town Trust Company, which were granted by chapter two hundred and forty-seven of the private and special laws of nineteen hundred and five, are hereby extended for two years from the approval of this act; and the persons named in said act, their associates and successors, shall have all the rights, powers and privileges that were granted them by said act, to be exercised in the same manner and for the same purpose as specified in said act.

Charter extended.

Section 2. This act shall take effect when approved.

Approved March 20, 1907.

**Chapter 319.**

An Act to amend and extend the charter rights, powers and purposes of the Sebec Power Company as authorized by Chapter two hundred nine of the Private and Special Laws of the state of Maine for the year nineteen hundred five.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The Sebec Power Company shall have power and authority to acquire by purchase, lease, merger or consolidation, all the properties, rights, privileges and franchises of the Milo Electric Light and Power Company, a corporation organized under the general laws of the state of Maine, and having its principal place of business at Milo in said state upon such terms and conditions as may be agreed upon by the stockholders of said companies and subject to the provisions of sections fifty-six to sixty-seven inclusive, of chapter forty-seven of the revised statutes and subject also to the rights of all creditors of each of said companies, and said Milo Electric Light and Power Company is hereby authorized and empowered to lease or sell and convey its property, rights, privileges and franchises to the Sebec Power Company, or to merge or consolidate with said Sebec Power Company.

Authorized to acquire property of Milo Electric Light and Power Co.

Section 2. The Sebec Power Company is hereby authorized and empowered to acquire by purchase, lease, merger, consolidation, or otherwise, the property, rights, privileges and franchises of any other company engaged in selling and distributing electricity for lighting purposes in the county of Piscataquis whose lines as constructed or chartered would form connecting or continuing lines with lines of the Sebec Power Company, which by

May acquire rights and property of other corporations.
