ten notice, signed by all, postage paid, to each of the other corporators, seven days at least before the day of the meeting, naming the time, place and purpose of such meeting, and at such meeting the necessary officers may be chosen, by-laws adopted, and any other corporate business transacted.

Section II. This act shall take effect when approved.

Chapter 378.

An Act to regulate fishing in Spear Stream in the County of Oxford, also its tributaries.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to fish for, take, catch or kill any kind of fish at any time in Spear stream, so called, in the county of Oxford, except that on Tuesday and Thursday of each week it shall be lawful to fish therein in accordance with the general law of the state.

Close time for fishing in Spear stream.

Section 2. It shall be unlawful for any person to fish at any time for any kind of fish in any of the tributaries to said Spear stream.

Fishing in tributaries of Spear stream, prohibited.

Section 3. Whoever violates any of the provisions of this act shall be subject to a penalty of not less than ten dollars nor more than thirty dollars for each offense and costs, and a further penalty of one dollar for each fish taken, caught, killed, or had in possession in violation of the provisions of this act.

Penalty for violation of this act.

Chapter 379.

An Act to amend Section one of Chapter three hundred and seventeen of the Special Laws of nineteen hundred and one, entitled "An Act to protect lobsters in the waters adjacent to the shores of the town of Lubec and Trescott."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section one of chapter three hundred and seventeen of the private and special laws of nineteen hundred and one is hereby amended by adding after the word "of" in the second line the words 'January and the first day of April, and also between the first day of,' so that said section will read as amended:

Section 1, chapter 317, private and special laws, 1901, amended.
