Chapter 384.

An Act relating to the Old Town Municipal Court, in the County of Penobscot.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 24,
Chapter 153,
special laws
1903,
amended.

Section 1. Section twenty-four of chapter one hundred and fifty-three of the special laws of the year one thousand nine hundred and three, relating to the Old Town municipal court, is hereby amended by striking out the word "executive" in the third line of said section and inserting in place thereof the word 'exclusive,' so that said section as amended, shall read as follows:

'Section 24. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but nothing in this act shall be construed to authorize said court to infringe upon the exclusive jurisdictions heretofore conferred upon other municipal courts in said county of Penobscot except so far as such exclusive jurisdictions may be affected by the provisions of section four of this act.'

Section 2. The said Old Town municipal court, in addition to the jurisdiction in criminal matters heretofore conferred upon and now possessed by it, shall have original jurisdiction concurrent with the supreme judicial court in the county of Penobscot, of the offenses described in sections seventy-four and eighty of chapter fifty-two of the revised statutes, and, upon conviction, may punish for said crimes or offenses in the manner and to the extent now provided in said sections seventy-four and eighty.

Salary of
recorder,
fixed.

Section 3. The salary of the recorder of said court is hereby fixed at four hundred dollars, annually, to be paid quarterly from the treasury of the county of Penobscot.

Section 4. This act shall take effect when approved.
