Chapter 425.

An Act to provide for a Clerk for the Register of Deeds for the Northern Registry of Deeds for Aroostook County.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

The register of deeds for the northern registry of deeds of Clerk Aroostook county is hereby authorized to employ a clerk to assist said register of deeds in the performance of the duties of the office, and the sum of three hundred dollars is hereby appropriated for the compensation of said clerk.

Chapter 426.

An Act to incorporate the Wilton Water District,

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section I. The following territory and the people within Corporate the same, namely, the town of Wilton, except lot number sixteen, according to a plan of said town, shall constitute a public municipal corporation under the name of the Wilton Water District for the purposes of supplying the inhabitants of said district and of the villages of North Jay and Bean's Corner in the town of Jay, and said municipalities with pure water for domestic, sanitary and municipal purposes.

Section 2. The said district for the purposes of its incorporation is hereby authorized to take, hold, divert, use and distribute water from Varnum pond, Wilson lake, or from any spring not in actual use for domestic purposes, or any pond, sources. brook or other waters in the town of Wilton, or from Hill's pond in Perkins plantation.

May take water from Varnum pond, Wilson lake

Section 3. The said district, for the purposes of its incor- May take poration, is hereby authorized to take and hold, as for public water rights.
