Section 21. This act shall take effect when approved by the governor, so far as necessary to empower the calling and holding of the elections authorized in sections seventeen and eighteen hereof.

Approved March 27, 1907.

Chapter 434.

An Act to authorize the County Commissioners of Washington County to create a sinking fund for the purpose of paying the bonded debt of said County.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Sinking fund authorized. Section 1. The county commissioners of the county of Washington are hereby authorized to create a sinking fund for the purpose of paying the bonded debt of said county.

Duty of county commissioners. Section 2. Such sums as shall be raised on property or taken from any surplus in the county treasury for that purpose shall be severally invested by the commissioners of said county upon a two-thirds vote of said county commissioners and the senators and representatives of the legislature from said county present at a meeting called by said commissioners for that purpose, and said sums shall be reinvested as occasion may require in the name of said county and in the manner herein provided until required to be used in the payment of said bonded indebtedness of said county.

Meetings, how called. Section 3. Meetings provided for in section two of this act shall be called by the county commissioners by a registered letter addressed by them to all members of the legislature from said county, naming the date, place and object of the meeting at least seven days before the same.

Expenses for attending meetings, how paid. Section 4. Senators and representatives attending any meeting called under the provisions of section three of this act shall be paid from the county treasury of said county, actual expenses of attendance of said meetings upon an order drawn by the county commissioners.

Section 5. This act shall take effect when approved.
