opening said court, then any trial justice or justice of the peace in the county of Oxford may preside for the purpose of entering and continuing actions, and filing papers in said court, and may adjourn said court from time to time without detriment to any action, returnable or pending, and may in his discretion, adjourn said court without day, in which event all actions returned or pending, shall be considered as continued to the next term. No trial justice or justice of the peace shall be disqualified from presiding for the purposes mentioned in this section, by reason of his being interested in any action returnable before or pending in said court.'

Section 2. This act shall take effect when approved.

Chapter 444.

An Act fixing the compensation of the Clerk of the Municipal Court for the City of Lewiston.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Compensation of
clerk fixed.

Section 1. The clerk of the municipal court for the city of Lewiston shall receive an annual salary of twelve hundred dollars, with five hundred dollars additional for clerk hire, from said city in quarterly payments, which said sums shall be in full compensation for the performance of all duties required of said clerk by law. He shall account quarterly under oath, to wit, on the first days of January, April, July and October of each year to the treasurer of the city of Lewiston for all fees received by him or payable to him by virtue of his office, specifying the items, and shall pay the whole amount of the same to the treasurer of the city of Lewiston quarterly on the days aforesaid.

Section 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
