Chapter 19.

Resolve in favor of the Children's Aid Society of Maine.

Resolved, That the sum of fifteen hundred dollars for the year nineteen hundred and seven and fifteen hundred dollars for the year nineteen hundred and eight be and hereby is appropriated to be paid to the Children's Aid Society of Maine, to aid in maintaining the home for friendless and destitute girls at Belfast.

Chapter 20.

Resolve in favor of King's Daughters' Union of Bangor.

Resolved, That the sum of five hundred dollars for the year nineteen hundred and seven, and five hundred dollars for the year nineteen hundred and eight, be and hereby is appropriated for the purpose of assisting and maintaining the King's Daughters' Union of Bangor.

Chapter 21.

Resolve in favor of Eastern Maine Insane Hospital.

Resolved, That the sum of seventy-five thousand dollars be and hereby is appropriated for and in behalf of the Eastern Maine Insane Hospital at Bangor for the year nineteen hundred and seven and seventy-five thousand dollars for the year nineteen hundred and eight for the purpose of constructing a new wing.
