CHAP. 35**Chapter 35.**

Resolve in favor of the Maine Insane Hospital.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the sum of forty-five thousand dollars, for the use of the Maine insane hospital, for the purpose of reconstructing the first male wing.

Said sum to be expended under the direction of the trustees of insane hospitals.

Resolve in favor of Kingman and Drew Plantation.

Resolved, That the sum of two thousand dollars be and is hereby appropriated to aid in building a road from Kingman village to Sprague's mill in Drew plantation. Said sum to be drawn by, and expended under the direction of the county commissioners of Penobscot county.

Chapter 37.

Resolve in favor of Lettie Whittier of Mount Vernon.

Resolved, That there be paid to Lettie Whittier, widow of Howard Whittier, late of Mount Vernon, county of Kennebec, the sum of six dollars per month, payable quarterly from the fund appropriated for military pensions and to begin January first, nineteen hundred and seven.

Chapter 38.

Resolve in favor of the Maine Eye and Ear Infirmary.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated annually the sum of five thousand dollars to be paid to the treasurer of the Maine Eye and Ear Infirmary for the use of said institution for the years nineteen hundred and seven and nineteen hundred and eight.
