Chapter 39.

Resolve in favor of J. W. Allen, Secretary of the Committee on State Prison.

Resolved, That the sum of two hundred and forty-eight dollars and fifty cents be paid J. W. Allen, secretary of the Committee on Maine State Prison to defray expenses incurred by him on account of the visit of said committee to the Maine State Prison at Thomaston during the present session in compliance with its official duties.

Chapter 40.

Resolve in favor of the Waldo County General Hospital.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the sum of one thousand five hundred dollars for the year nineteen hundred and seven, and one thousand five hundred dollars for the year nineteen hundred and eight to be paid to the Waldo County Hospital Association for the use of the Waldo County General Hospital.

Chapter 41.

Resolve in favor of Knox County General Hospital.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the sum of fifteen hundred dollars to be paid to the Knox County General Hospital for the general use of said institution for the year nineteen hundred and seven, and fifteen hundred dollars for the year nineteen hundred and eight; also the sum of fifteen hundred dollars for the year nineteen hundred and seven for the purpose of maintenance and repair of or additions to its buildings and grounds.
