Chapter 49.

Resolve in favor of the official reporter of the Senate.

Edward K.
Milliken,

Resolved, That there be paid to Edward K. Milliken, the official reporter of the senate, the sum of three hundred dollars, for assistance employed by him at the present session of the legislature.

Chapter 50.

Resolve in favor of a building for the Tubercular Insane.

Tubercular

to provide
for treat-
ment of.

Resolved, That the sum of thirty thousand dollars be and hereby is appropriated for the construction and equipment of a building for the proper isolation and treatment of the tubercular insane confined in the two state asylums. The same to be built in connection with the Eastern Maine insane hospital, under the supervision of the trustees of the insane hospitals.

Chapter 51.

Resolve in aid of the Temporary Home for Women and Children at Portland.

Resolved, That the sum of five thousand dollars be and hereby is appropriated for the use of the Temporary Home for Women and Children at Portland, of which two thousand five hundred dollars shall be paid to said institution during the year nineteen hundred and seven, and two thousand five hundred dollars during the year nineteen hundred and eight.
