Chapter 67.

Resolve in favor of Nicholas Sockabasin, representative of Penobscot tribe of Indians.

Resolved, That the sum of one hundred and twenty dollars be and is hereby appropriated to pay representative of the Penobscot tribe of Indians, for his travel and attendance at this session of the legislature, for the year nineteen hundred and seven.

Resolve in favor of the Deaconess Home Association at Bangor.
