Chapter 75.

Resolve in favor of the town of Hodgdon.

Resolved, That the sum of one hundred dollars be and is hereby appropriated to be paid to the town of Hodgdon, to correct an error of the county commissioners of Aroostook county in regard to the amount due from the state to the town of Hodgdon for state road for the year nineteen hundred and five.

Chapter 78.

Resolve to encourage the utilization of tidal and sea power in the State of Maine.

Resolved, That for the purpose of demonstrating the efficacy of any mechanism for the utilization of tidal and sea power, the invention of a citizen of Maine and upon his request, the governor and council are authorized to expend for the service of mechanical experts the sum of five hundred dollars, which is hereby appropriated.
