Chapter 84.

Resolve in aid of navigation on Sebec Lake.

In aid of

Resolved, That the sum of three hundred dollars is hereby appropriated for the placing of buoys and erection of lights in Sebec lake and the maintenance of the same for the year nineteen hundred and seven, and the sum of three hundred dollars is hereby appropriated for the placing of buoys and erection of lights in Sebec lake and the maintenance of the same for the year nineteen hundred and eight. All said money shall be expended under the direction of the state steamboat inspectors; and any part of the money hereby appropriated which shall be unexpended at the end of the year nineteen hundred and eight shall revert to the state.

Chapter 85.

Resolve in favor of the State School for Boys.

State School

in favor of.

Resolved, That there be and are hereby appropriated for and in behalf of the State School for Boys the following sums and for the following purposes, namely: For the year nineteen hundred and seven, for current expenses, twenty-six thousand dollars; for ordinary repairs and improvements, two thousand dollars; for providing homes for boys and visiting boys out on probation, two hundred fifty dollars; for insurance premiums on the property of the State School for Boys, two hundred fifty-two dollars; for construction of a piggery, three thousand two hundred dollars; for construction of vegetable cellar, three thousand dollars; for construction of ice house, seven hundred fifty dollars; for extraordinary repairs and improvements, including the completion of the work on the administration building, and furnishings, eleven thousand eight hundred sixty dollars. For the year nineteen hundred and eight, for current expenses, twenty-six thousand dollars; for ordinary repairs and improvements, two thousand dollars; for providing homes for boys and visiting boys out on probation, two hundred fifty dollars; for insurance premiums on the property of the State School for Boys, one hundred dollars; for construction of a stable, three thousand seven hundred dollars.
