CHAP. 89**Chapter 89.**

Resolve in favor of the Maine State Library.

Resolved, That the sum of six thousand and sixty-one dollars be and hereby is appropriated for the use of the Maine State Library for the year nineteen hundred and seven, and that a like sum be and is hereby appropriated for the year nineteen hundred and eight; the same to be expended for books, material, supplies, labor, contingent expenses and the general maintenance and support of said library.

Chapter 90.

Resolve in favor of a monument in memory of the Soldiers of Maine who were at Valley Forge.

Resolved, That the sum of five hundred dollars be appropriated for the purpose of erecting at Valley Forge, Pennsylvania, a monument in memory of the soldiers from Maine who were at Valley Forge with the continental army under Washington in the winter of seventeen hundred and seventy-seven and seven-teen hundred and seventy-eight.

Chapter 91.

Resolve for an appropriation for carrying on the work of the State Survey Commission.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated for the work of the state survey commission, the sum of ten thousand dollars for the year nineteen hundred and seven and a like sum for the year nineteen hundred and eight, to be expended in accordance with the provisions of chapter one hundred forty-four, public laws of nineteen hundred and five.
