**Chapter 92.**

Resolve in favor of the Town of Waldoboro.

*Resolved*, That the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars be paid to the treasurer of the town of Waldoboro to reimburse said town for taxes improperly assessed for the years nineteen hundred and four and nineteen hundred and five, upon the schooner Singleton Palmer.

**Chapter 93.**

Resolve in favor of the Town of Liberty for money paid out on account of state roads.

*Resolved*, That the sum of one hundred and ten dollars be and hereby is appropriated to be paid to the town of Liberty for the purpose of reimbursing said town, for money paid out on account of state roads during the year of nineteen hundred and three under the provisions of chapter twenty-three of the revised statutes.

**Chapter 94.**

Resolve in favor of Margaret Jane Tibbetts of Hermon.

*Resolved*, That there be paid out of the treasury of the state a pension of twelve dollars per month to Margaret Jane Tibbetts of Hermon dependent mother of Horace Tibbetts deceased, beginning January first, nineteen hundred and seven and to continue during the pleasure of the legislature.

**Chapter 95.**

Resolve in favor of the Assessors of Moro Plantation.

*Resolved*, That there be and is hereby appropriated to be paid to the assessors of Moro plantation in the county of Aroostook, the sum of one hundred seventy-seven dollars and fifty cents to reimburse them for expenses incurred in fighting forest fire in the summer of nineteen hundred and five.
