Chapter * 103.

Resolve in favor of the Western State Normal School at Gorham.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the sum of three thousand two hundred and fifty dollars for the year nineteen hundred and seven and three thousand two hundred and fifty dollars for the year nineteen hundred and eight for the Western State Normal School at Gorham, the same to be expended by and under the direction of the trustees of the normal schools for the state.

Chapter 104.

Resolve in favor of the City of Augusta.

Resolved, That the state treasurer is hereby authorized and City of directed to pay to the treasurer of the city of Augusta the sum Augusta, in favor of. of eight hundred and ninety dollars and fifty-four cents, the same being an abatement of the taxes assessed upon the real and personal property in said city for the years nineteen hundred and five and nineteen hundred and six, by reason of an over valuation thereof.

Chapter 105.

Resolve in favor of Town of Topsfield in Washington County.

Resolved, That the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars be Town of and hereby is appropriated to be paid to the town of Topsfield, in favor of. in Washington county, to remunerate the town for money expended on state road in nineteen hundred and five.
