Resolved, That the secretary of state shall prepare and furnish to the several cities, towns and plantations, ballots and blank returns in conformity to the foregoing resolves accompanied by a copy thereof.

Approved March 20, 1907.

Chapter 122.

Resolve in favor of Dana L. Theriault to reimburse him for expenses incurred in contested election in Fort Kent class.

Resolved, That the sum of one hundred and thirty dollars be appropriated to reimburse representative Dana L. Theriault for necessary expenses incurred in the contested election in the Fort Kent class.

Chapter 123.

Resolve in aid of repairs of road leading from Northwest Carry on Moosehead Lake to the Pittston farm on the West Branch of the Penobscot River.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the sum of seven hundred and fifty dollars to aid in the repair of the road leading from the northwest carry on Moosehead lake to the Pittston farm at the confluence of the north and south branches of the west branch of the Penobscot river. The same to be expended under the direction of an agent to be appointed for that purpose by the governor and council.

Chapter 124.

Resolve to provide for repairs of road leading from Roach River to the Grant Farm.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the sum of one thousand two hundred and fifty dollars to aid in the repair of road leading from Roach river to the Grant farm, so called, near the outlet of Ragged lake. The same to be expended upon that portion of the road between the southerly line of township one, range thirteen, Piscataquis county, and the Grant farm, under the direction of an agent to be appointed for that purpose by the governor and council.
