Chapter 128.

Resolve in favor of E. J. Crosby, Secretary of the Committee on Agriculture.

Resolved, That the sum of one hundred dollars and thirty cents be paid E. J. Crosby, secretary of the committee on agriculture, to defray expense incurred by him on account of the visit of said committee to the University of Maine at Orono, during the present session in compliance with its official duties.

Resolve in favor of the Town of Stockton Springs.

Resolved, That the sum of seventy-five dollars be appropriated and paid to the town of Stockton Springs from the state treasury, to reimburse said town for bounty paid on seals in nineteen hundred and five.

Resolve in favor of the Town of Mariaville.
