**Chapter 148.**

Resolve providing for assistance in rebuilding the East Branch bridge in the town of Oakfield.

Bridge across east branch of Mattawamkeag river, to assist in rebuilding.

*Resolved,* That there be and is hereby appropriated the sum of seven hundred and fifty dollars to aid in rebuilding the bridge across the east branch of the Mattawamkeag river near Oakfield station in the town of Oakfield, Aroostook county, provided that the amount herein appropriated be expended under the direction of the state highway commissioner and the Aroostook county commissioners, and provided further that the appropriation of seven hundred and fifty dollars be conditional upon the expenditure of a like sum by the town of Oakfield.

Approved March 22, 1907.

**Chapter 149.**

Resolve in favor of the town of Howland for purpose of repairing bridge across Seboeis River.

Town of Howland, bridge across Seboeis river, in aid of.

*Resolved,* That the sum of one hundred dollars be and hereby is appropriated for and in behalf of the town of Howland, to be expended under the direction of the road commissioner of said town for the purpose of repairing bridge across the Seboeis river in said town.

Approved March 22, 1907.

**Chapter 150.**

Resolve in favor of the Towns of Howland and Enfield for the purpose of repairing bridge across the Penobscot River.

Towns of Howland and Enfield, in favor of.

*Resolved,* That the sum of thirteen hundred dollars be and hereby is appropriated for and in behalf of the towns of Howland and Enfield to be expended under the direction of the road commissioner of said towns for the purpose of repairing the bridge across the Penobscot river between said towns.
