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**Chapter 151.**

Resolve in favor of the Town of Bingham.

*Resolved*, That the sum of five hundred sixty-four dollars and three cents be and is hereby appropriated to aid the town of Bingham in building and repairing the highway leading to the Bingham and Concord bridge, to be expended under the direction of the county commissioners of Somerset county.

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**Chapter 153.**

*Resolved*, That the sum of two thousand dollars be paid to the city of Gardiner and the town of Randolph to assist in the care, maintenance and repair of the Gardiner and Randolph bridge, so called, for the year nineteen hundred and seven, and the same amount to be paid the said city and town for the year nineteen hundred and eight for the same purposes.
