Resolve in favor of the Town of Bingham.

Resolved, That the sum of five hundred sixty-four dollars and Town of three cents be and is hereby appropriated to aid the town of Bingham, in aid of building and repairing the highway leading to the highway in. Bingham and Concord bridge, to be expended under the direction of the county commissioners of Somerset county.
