CHAP. 154**Chapter 154.**

Resolve in favor of Wilber Grant of Kingman, Maine.

Land agent
authorized
to convey to
Wilber Grant
certain land.

Resolved, That the land agent be authorized and directed to convey to Wilber Grant of Kingman, Maine, lot number seventy in the town of Island Falls, in the county of Aroostook, formerly known as township number four, range four, west of the east line of the state, he having already paid the full value therefor.

Chapter 155.

Resolve in favor of the Town of Buxton.

Resolved, That the sum of one hundred twenty-six dollars and forty-seven cents be appropriated to reimburse the town of Buxton in the county of York and state of Maine, for money expended by it during the years eighteen hundred ninety-nine, nineteen hundred, nineteen hundred one, nineteen hundred two and nineteen hundred six in furnishing pauper supplies to Henry Grady.

Chapter 156.

Resolve in favor of James W. Doughty.

Resolved, That the sum of two hundred dollars be and is hereby appropriated to be paid to James W. Doughty, for medical services and supplies rendered destitute inhabitants of Malaga island as pauper supplies.
