Chapter 157.

Resolve to appropriate five hundred dollars to screen Snow Pond, or Messalonskee Lake, so called, in the County of Kennebec.

Resolved, That the sum of five hundred dollars be and is hereby appropriated for the purpose of screening Snow pond, or Messalonskee lake, so called, in the county of Kennebec, to be expended under the direction of the commissioners of inland fisheries and game, when the balance necessary to erect said screen, as found by the commissioners, shall have been raised by the citizens of the county of Kennebec, and paid in to the treasurer of state for this purpose, to aid in erecting this screen.

Provided, further, that this appropriation shall not be available until the town of Oakland shall, in legal town meeting, and having an article in the warrant for said town meeting for that purpose, by vote of record, voted to assume all liability for the keeping of said screen at all times free from sticks, leaves and all debris, so that the same will not become clogged and prevent the free running of the water through the same.

Proviso.

Chapter 158.

Resolve in favor of Benjamin F. Brown.

Resolved, That there be allowed and paid out of the treasury to the said Benjamin F. Brown the sum of forty-eight dollars, which sum was granted him by the thirty-first legislature, in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and fifty-two, chapter three hundred eighty-eight, and approved February twenty-six, eighteen hundred and fifty-two.
