Chapter 161.

Resolve in favor of Bridgton Academy.

Resolved, That there be appropriated for the use of the Trustees of Bridgton Academy the sum of three thousand dollars for the purpose of building a dormitory, installing heat, and for the purchase of furniture for the building, provided that at least an equal sum be raised by the trustees of said academy for the same purpose.

Chapter 162.

Resolve providing for the amendment of section seventeen, chapter sixty of the Revised Statutes, relating to the use of the score card by Agricultural Societies.

Resolved, That such portion of section seventeen, chapter sixty of the revised statutes as pertains to the use of the score card system in the judging of horses, cattle, sheep and swine be stricken out, so that the section as amended, shall read as follows:

section 17,
chapter 60,

stricken out.

'Section 17. The payment of the annual appropriations to the state fairs and the payment of the state stipend to all other agricultural societies receiving a three hundred dollar stipend or more shall be conditional upon the use of the score card system in the judging of dairy products. A copy of each score card as filled by the judge shall be delivered to the exhibitor of each exhibit.'

Chapter 163.

Resolve in favor of the enlargement and completion of the Fish Culture Station at Raymond, Maine.

Resolved, That the sum of five thousand dollars is hereby appropriated for the year nineteen hundred and seven and five thousand dollars for the year nineteen hundred and eight for the purpose of enlarging and completing the fish hatchery at Raymond, Maine. The same to be expended by the commissioners of inland fisheries and game under the direction of the governor and council.
