**Chapter 167.**

Resolve providing for the repair of bridges in Macwahoc Plantation.

*Resolved*, That there be and hereby is appropriated the sum of twelve hundred and fifty dollars for repairing the bridge across Molunkus stream and the bridge across Macwahoc stream, both being on the state military road, so called, in Macwahoc plantation in the county of Aroostook, provided that the money hereby appropriated shall be expended under the direction of the state commissioner of highways and the county commissioners of Aroostook county and the unexpended balance, if any, shall be returned to the state treasury.

**Chapter 168.**

Resolve in favor of the Town of Union.

*Resolved*, That there be and hereby is appropriated the sum of twenty-five hundred dollars to be expended in the erection of an iron bridge over the Georges river near Union common upon the direct road from Augusta to Rockland.

**Chapter 169.**

Resolve in relation to Fort William Henry in the town of Bristol.

*Resolved*, That there be and hereby is appropriated the sum of three thousand dollars for the use of the Pemaquid commissioners, the same to be used for the erection of a memorial tower on the foundations of the castle or flanking tower of Fort William Henry, and for the preservation of the remains of said fort, and for such other purposes connected with the care of the reservation and state property thereunto appertaining as may, in their judgment, be necessary.
